Minimum Assistance Therapeutic Rider – (W/T/J) English & Western compete together. **No age restriction.** For riders who are unable to participate without assistance. One attendant permitted. *Classes for Division – 14, 15, 23, 24, 25, 99, 103, 108*

Maximum Assistance Therapeutic Rider – (W/T/J) English & Western compete together. **No age restriction.** For riders who are unable to participate without assistance. Multiple attendants permitted. *Classes for Division – 14, 15, 23, 24, 25, 99, 103, 108*

Note: Minimum & Maximum Assistance Division are ridden together but judged separately in most classes.

Western Lead Line -. Children 10 years of age and under. Multiple attendants are permitted to enter the arena if needed. *Classes for Division – 16, 26, 27, 28, 100, 105, 110*

English Lead Line -. Children 10 years of age and under. Multiple attendants are permitted to enter the arena if needed. *Classes for Division – 16, 29, 30, 31, 100, 105, 110*

Western Novice Youth Pleasure – Riders age (11-18) for riders that are not comfortable with gates above Trot/Jog. (Walk/Jog/Trot) *Classes for Division – 11 or 13, 17 or 19 or 21, 35, 36, 37, 100, 105, 110*

English Novice Youth Pleasure – Riders age (11-18) for riders that are not comfortable with gates above Trot/Jog. (Walk/Jog/Trot) *Classes for Division – 11 or 12, 18 or 20 or 22, 38, 39, 40, 100, 105, 110*

Western 10 & Under Pleasure – (Walk/Jog). *Classes for Division – 11 or 13, 17, 41, 42, 43, 100, 105, 110*

English 10 & Under Pleasure – (Walk/Trot) *Classes for Division – 11 or 12, 18, 44, 45, 46, 100, 105, 110*

Western Junior Youth Pleasure – Riders age 14 and under. Gates call will be Walk, Jog or Lope. *Classes for Division – 11 or 13, 19, 54, 55, 56, 101, 106, 111*

English Junior Youth Pleasure – Riders age 14 and under. Gates call will be Walk, Trot or Canter. *Classes for Division – 11 or 12, 20, 57, 58, 59, 101, 106, 111*

Western Senior Youth Pleasure – Riders age 15 - 18. Gates call will be walk, Trot or Jog, Canter or Lope. *Classes for Division – 11 or 13, 21, 60, 61, 62, 102, 107, 112*

English Senior Youth Pleasure – Riders age 15 - 18. Gates call will be walk, Trot or Jog, Canter or Lope. *Classes for Division – 11 or 12, 22, 63, 64, 65, 102, 107, 112*

Open Divisions – May enter any that are appropriate.

Sport Horse - this division is designed to show the movement and versatility of equine suited to equestrian sporting events dressage, eventing, show jumping Shown in Hunt or Dressage tack and attire. *Classes for Division – 50, 51, 52, 97, 98*

Ranch Horse – Ranch horse classes are designed to show the movement and versatility of the working ranch-style horse. Western Tack and attire. *Classes for Division – 89, 90, 91, 92*

Miniature Horse –Open to handlers of any age. *Classes for Division – 93, 94, 104, 109*

Miniature Jumping –Open to handlers of any age. *Classes for Division – 95 & 96*

Miniature Driving –Open to handlers of any age. *Classes for Division – 86, 87, 88*

Hunter –Open to rider in English tack Helmets required. *Classes for Division – 1, 2, 7, 8, 9, 10*

Cross rails –Open to rider in English tack Helmets required. *Classes for Division – 3 & 4 or 5 & 6*

Gymkhana Divisions – This division is open to riders showing any seat. Choose either Trot or Canter division

Gymkhana (Trot) - Open to riders any age who are not yet comfortable with a faster gait. Canter strides will be penalized. Classes for Division –69, 73, 77, 81, 84

Gymkhana (Canter) – Open to riders who have the ability to canter Classes for Division – 70, 74, 78, 82, 85

Required documentation:

Current Negative Coggins and proof of rabies vaccine -required for horse to be on the show grounds. Will be kept on file for future use.

Proof of membership or Membership application -complete with payment.

Horse/ Rider combination number registration -same number for the year and used to track year end points.

Horse / Rider Registration form -Used to track day end division awards and payment.

Individual class -registration slips are required. A full page of class registration slips is provided - to be cut apart at check in.

Day End High Point

Day End High Point Division Awards – Competitors may show in:

- **One** Pleasure Division (See choices of Pleasure divisions in the chart above). Note: **no** cross entering into any other pleasure divisions.
- **One** Gymkhana Division (Trot or Canter).
- **Any** of the Open Divisions (Ranch Horse Sport Horse, Miniature Horse, Miniature Jumping, Miniature Driving)

Points schedule: 1st Place= 6 points 2nd place = 5 points 3rd place = 4 points 4th place = 3 points 5th Place = 2 points 6th place = 1 point. Ties in a division will be determined by the most blue ribbons won, most red ribbons won through most green ribbons won respectively. The riders or handler with the highest points at the end of the show will be the division champion. Reserve to the next highest

Year-End Member Awards

WRC Year End Member Division Awards – WRC club members are eligible for one pleasure, one gymkhana and any of the appropriate open division awards. The points collected in classes entered in the selected division plus a point for every class entered is included for the divisional awards. Opportunity class points are applied to these awards. The selection of division from this show determines the year end division for the Year-end Member award.

WRC Member Overall Top 10 Year End Awards – WRC club members have an opportunity to collect points for high point overall awards. Points are accumulated on a Horse/ Rider combination. Points that are earned in each class of a WRC show plus a point for every class entered are tallied.

Membership: Forms can be found on the website and at the show office. Member points are kept on Horse/ Rider combination for each show. Points for Member awards count when the membership is submitted. Any points earned prior to submission will not count toward Member High Point Awards, be sure to sign up before you show. In order to be eligible for Member year end awards. It is your responsibility to ensure we have your volunteer time and/or donation logged with us in the office by June 4th 2017. All awards are given at the year end banquet November 4th, 2017 to members in good standing with the club.

Fees: Make checks payable to WRC. Any returned check for insufficient funds shall be charged additional fees and placed on a cash basis

Entry Fee: \$8 per class. (Note: Trainer or farm checks will not be accepted for a group of students) Family members may be paid with one check. Office opens at 7:00am please allow the office ample time to process entries. The show will start on time. No hold unless office authorizes it.

Number Fee: All entries will be charged a \$2.00 number fee. A onetime number fee for each horse rider combination will be charged. Points will be tracked with this number. This number will be used for all WRC shows. This fee is not refundable. Rider is responsible for having the number on and for the condition of the number. If lost a replacement fee of \$2 will be charged.

Office Fee: A \$5 Office fee will be charged per horse/rider combination.

Grounds Fee: A \$5 Grounds fee will be applied to each entry except to 2017 WRC members. Proof of membership required.

General Rules:

1. Signed waivers must be on file with the show secretary prior to schooling. Youth riders must have a signed waiver by parent or legal guardian in order to school or show. Back numbers must be worn at all times. **All ages as of 1/1/17.**

2. Adding classes must be done a minimum of 2 classes in advance. Add forms must be used.

3. **No refunds for scratched or missed classes!**

Notify the office immediately in the event of illness or injury to rider or equine. The show manager will document an incident report.

4. Gymkhana Attire: Riders must wear long pants, shirt with sleeve (short sleeves acceptable – no spaghetti strap tops) and riding shoe with heel.

5. Show attire is expected for Pleasure divisions. Judge will not disqualify rider for lack of appointments but may deduct points.

6. Timed Events: Riders must wait until the gate is closed to begin their run.

7. **Cancellation of Classes** – Under circumstances deemed unsafe by the show committee, a class may be postponed to a later date or cancelled.

In the case of Thunderstorm. The show manager will call a halt to the show in the event of lightening. A 30 minutes hold time is required after lightening is observed. The show committee will deem whether to continue with the show or delay an additional length of time. Delay may be up to a total of a 2 hour hold period. The exhibitors will have the opportunity to be refunded for the classes they could not complete in. If the exhibitor can attend the rain date, the fees and paperwork can be held over. The number fee, office fee and the grounds fee will not be returned.

8. **Conduct Expectations of Competitors** - The WRC Shows are meant to be a fun, family oriented and competitive environment for riders to demonstrate their horsemanship skills. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated by competitors, trainers, parents and/or spectators. This includes but is not limited to the mishandling of an equine and unacceptable language. If unsportsmanlike conduct is observed, the violator will be asked to leave the grounds and forfeit any and all entry fees. Trainers, parents and spectators displaying such behavior will be asked to vacate the premises.
