Is It Aging or Is It Alzheimer's?

Ron St. John, Alzheimer's/Dementia Care Director at Visiting Angels of Central Florida, a senior homecare organization in Sanford, will be our featured speaker this month. His thought-provoking presentation will provide insight into ways to help caregivers of Alzheimer's and dementia patients cope with the effects of this devastating illness.

St. John will discuss his own personal experience as a long-term caregiver for his mother, who suffered from Alzheimer's. He will also talk about his work as former director of a 38-bed Memory Care community, and consultant at the Alzheimer's and Dementia Resource Center in Orlando.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Some of my favorite memories involve celebrity encounters--from my days as a trade magazine editor in Manhattan (when I interviewed ice cream maven Tom Carvel, Perdue Farms' Frank Perdue, and fashion designer Diane von Furstenberg) to my interview with rock star Jimi Hendrix when I was a high school student working in the office of my father's auto body shop.

Imagine my surprise, then, to learn that our very own Parliamentarian, Susan Murray, had a real world connection to this month's musical entertainment. Rev. Shawn Garvey's beautiful renditions of classic John Denver tunes delighted the 80 ladies in the audience at Tusawilla Country Club and evoked fond memories for Susan Murray! Thanks to Program Co-VP Joan Hansen for introducing us to this talented entertainer (and ordained minister) who "filled up our senses" with wonderful music and lyrics --and to all of you who helped make the first luncheon of our 2014-2015 program year such a resounding success. Thanks also to Joan Lenard for delivering the monthly Inspiration at our meeting, and to our Co-VP-Luncheons, Joan Bové and Diane Olivi, for selecting the menu and booking our group at such a lovely venue. Remember that we expect to be back at Tusawilla Country Club November 13 for our semi-annual Game Day.

Susan Murray's connection to John Denver and his music started in the late 1960's, when she saw him perform with the Chad Mitchell Trio in Washington, DC. From the 1960's to the 1990's, she attended more John Denver concerts than she can count. After John Denver founded his environmental Windstar Foundation to encourage individuals to act locally in efforts that would eventually have global impact, Susan joined other fans in Chicago to form the Windstar Chicago Chapter in 1986. Then in July 1989, they brought John Denver to the Chicago Theater to present a Higher Ground educational event, a mixture of songs, videos and speakers designed to inspire more people to become involved in environmental conservation. In 1990, as part of this movement, Susan and her first husband helped launch a recycling program in their suburban Chicago city.

Susan fondly remembers the times she met John Denver before he passed away in 1997, and still considers him her favorite singer. When she went on her first date with her future husband, Paul Murray, he was playing a John Denver CD. Although they were high school sweethearts who reconnected at their 40th reunion, they had never even talked about their musical tastes before. After that, "There Was Never a Doubt in My Mind," says Susan, who played several John Denver songs at their 2008 wedding! If you have a great personal story to tell, let me know. 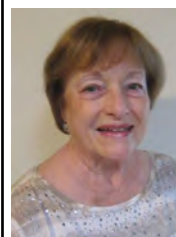


John Denver inspired the audience at the Higher Ground environmental conference in Chicago in July 1989.



One of Susan Murray's treasured memories is this 1989 photo of her with her favorite singer and songwriter, John Denver.

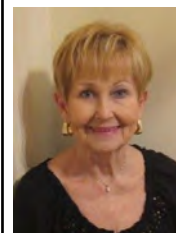
MEET OUR MEMBERS

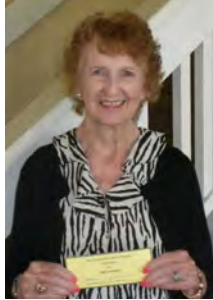
