CALL TO ORDER and ROLL CALL

The monthly meeting of the Mill Creek Water Reclamation District Board of Trustees ("District") was called to order at 7:00 p.m. at the SSA Office in the Mill Creek Village Center, 39W250 Herrington Blvd., Ste. R-1, Blackberry Township, Illinois. Trustees Dougherty, Hammond and D'Andrea were present in person.

- 3. Announcements and Public Comment. Trustee Dougherty stated that the meeting is available to attend telephonically as noticed in the agenda. Jason Fowler advised that as of 5:00 p.m. there were no emails with public comment and no one was present, on the phone line or in person.
- 4. **Public Hearing On 2024 Budget and Appropriation Ordinance**. Trustee Hammond made a motion to open the 2024 Budget Hearing. Trustee D'Andrea seconded the motion.

This information is contained in a memorandum he prepared and provided to the Trustees. Trustee Hammond asked if there were tips to how the committee should proceed. Radovich advised that the process should be kept simple and the idea is to determine where mutual aid can be provided, where actions can be consolidated and reduce taxpayer expenses.
