

MARION TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS MEETING June 9, 2015 Township Building

Present: Archie Gettig, Herb Chapman, and Angel Emery (Rick Dillon absent)

Guests: Brian McCauley, Morgan VanOuse, and Tim Weight

Chairman Gettig, called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chapman made a motion to approve the May meeting minutes as presented, Gettig seconded, motion passed 2-0

Public Comments: NO PUBLIC COMMENTS

New Business:

Uni-Tec- Morgan VanOuse presented plans for Triangle Trucking and Excavating. The Supervisors reviewed the plans along with the letter from Engineer, Don Franson. **On a motion by Gettig and second by Chapman, motion passed to conditionally approve Triangle Trucking plans at this time. 2-0**

Nittany Valley Joint Planning Commission- Gettig reported that the I-80 exchange was discussed and a Penn DOT representative will be at the next meeting which is July 16th at Walker Township.

Planning Commission- Nothing to Report.

Park & Rec- No Meeting. Nothing to Report.

Head Road master Report- Gettig briefly discussed.

Zoning Report- Weight reported that the Mobile Home Park fee is six months overdue. **On a motion by Gettig and second by Chapman, motion passed to have Weight send Ms. Yaw, owner of the mobile home park, a citation for not paying her fee. 2-0**

Weight talked about his proposed updates to the zoning application. **On a motion by Gettig and second by Chapman, motion passed to approve the revised zoning application for Marion Township. 2-0**

Zoning Hearing Board- **Gettig made a motion to approve Zoning Hearing Board members, Ed Poorman with a 2018 reappointment, Sam Haesler with a 2017 reappointment, and Jack Aberegg with a 2106 reappointment, Chapman seconded, motion passed 2-0.**

Newsletter- the Supervisors advised Emery to contact the fire chief's for Walker Township and Howard Fire Company to see if they have anything they would like to add to the newsletter.

BAHS Award Recipients- Gettig announced that Kaitlin Ladlee and Matthew Kern were the recipients of the Marion Township Award for BAHS.

Other Discussion Items:

Emery will be out of the office June 11th and June 30th.

The Supervisors spoke with McCauley about a Right to know request that the Township received for tax records, McCauley said that he will be taking care of it.

The Supervisors discussed if any exemptions are acceptable for septic pumping, for example, if no one is living in a rental property. Research is going to be done about the septic pumping regulations.

Gettig made a motion to send Mary Wilson a thank you for being so helpful to Emery and the Township, Chapman seconded, motion passed 2-0.

On a motion by Gettig and second by Chapman, motion passed to accept Treasurer's Report and pay bills as presented 2-0.

Gettig made a motion to adjourn at 8:07 p.m., Chapman seconded, motion passed 2-0.
