Arrival Time:

Families and contestants can begin arriving Friday. No vehicles are allowed on Racetrack.

Schedule:

Friday: Check in 5:00 PM (High/Junior High only)
Mandatory meeting 6:00 PM
Performance 1 7:00 PM (High/Junior High only)

Saturday: Slack 1 8 AM (High/Junior High only)
Maverick (Elementary) check in 8 AM
Maverick (Elementary) only 1st go 30 minutes after slack
Performance 2 7:00 PM (High/Junior High only)

Sunday: 7 AM Church Service
Maverick (Elementary) only 2nd go 8 AM
Slack 2 immediately following Maverick rodeo (High/Junior High only)

Trailer/Camper Hook-ups:

RV hookups, electric & water, 30/50 amp are \$70/weekend, generators are allowed.

Stalls:

Limited stalls \$40/weekend will draw and notify those who will have them. Also, have limited number of spots in covered arena you bring your own panels and set up/clean up \$20/weekend.

Admission:

Contestant and one guest gets in for free. Wristbands will be \$15/weekend for additional guest, children 9 and under free.

Concessions:

Concessions will be available onsite.

Check-in:

Check in will be done with your individual state. You must be in dress code to check in.

Mandatory Contestant Meeting:

Contestant meeting will begin at 6:00 Friday. **All contestants must attend meeting and be in dress code.** For safety purposes, contestants should not be on horseback during this time. High School remember meetings are mandatory and you must be there before roll call to be counted present.

We will do a rough stock equipment inspection immediately after meeting, be prepared.
