### **Shabbat Torah Studies**

## Vayyera (And He appeared) Genesis: 18<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>th</sup> chapter Questions

1 In the Torah readings Vayyera (Genesis 20: 2-7) and Lech Lecha (Genesis 12: 11-20) the actions of

Abraham almost made two people sin against the laws of the Almighty. What lesson(s) can be learned from these episodes?

- 2 Was Lot saved from the destruction because of his righteousness or that of Abraham's?
- 3 What did Abraham serve the three men (angels/messengers) to eat and drink that he encountered?
- 4 What elements did the Almighty use to destroy Sodom and Gomorrah?
- 5 Who visited Abimelech the king of Gerar in a dream?
- 6 Abraham and Sarah were blood siblings, they later became husband and wife. Did they violate the law in *Leviticus 18: 9*?
- 7 Is it <u>true</u>, <u>false</u>, or <u>unknown</u>? Lot's daughters were named Tovah and Tikvah.
- 8 In this Torah reading, where was the first place that the Almighty appeared to Abraham?
- 9 What does the word **Ishmael** mean?

### **After Reading the Torah Reading**

- 1 What is the major theme in this Torah reading, if there is any found in this Torah reading?
- 2 What did you learn after reading this Torah reading?

#### **Let Us Reason Together**


According to the information found in this Torah reading, Abimelech clearly knew the G-D of Abraham. Moreover, the Almighty prevented Abimelech from sinning. **Question:** Do you believe Abimelech and his people worshipped the Almighty and followed His laws, statutes and judgments. Or do you believe Abimelech and his people were aware of the Almighty but did not worship Him.

### **Deductive Analysis**

In this Torah reading it is revealed that Abraham and Lot were so wealthy that they could not coexist in close proximity of each other. After the great destruction of the two great cities (Sodom and Gomorrah) and the plains, would it be safe to say or assume that Abraham was wealthier than Lot.

#### **What Would You Do?**

What if you were stranded, lost and cut off from civilization and many days have passed. You haven't had any water or food during this period and your life is in the balance. Just when things look bleak you come across a pig, **Question:** Do you kill and eat the pig to stay alive and ask for forgiveness of the Almighty or do you hold fast to G-D's dietary law? **Explain for answer.**
