




Q2 What is your gender?







Q4 How many people live in your household?




Q6 I want to remain in my current home as I age


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Q7 I need or will need home modifications or alterations to have an accessible and safe home as I age.






Q10 What is your main mode of transportation?

Q11 How often do you use public transportation? ex. bus, ferry, SMART train





Q12 What transportation assistance do you currently need? Check all that apply





Q13 If you do not use public transportation currently, what prevents you from using it? Check all that apply.



Q14 What transportation services do you anticipate you might need in the future? Check all that apply.





Q15 How would you rate your physical health?









Q19 Do you provide care for another person in your home?





Q20 If you are a caregiver for someone in your household or for a friend, do you have respite help or a support system?








Q23 How often do you feel isolated?



Q24 Have you taken any classes offered through the Corte Madera Recreation Department?




Q27 What types of recreation classes or programs would you participate in if they were offered?




Q29 Do you serve as a volunteer?

Q36 Would you be interested in technology support and training?





Q37 Check all the ways you receive community-related information.


