REMINDER CONCERNING SOUTH DUMP

What is commonly referred to as the South Dump, is private property and only for the use of Amana Society stock holders living within the Amana Colonies, and may be under 24 hour photo surveillance.

Absolutely No burning is permitted at the South Dump. Burning is dangerous and not compliant with DNR Regulations.

Only organic compostable yard refuse is allowed, and users must empty & remove plastic bags or other containers used to transfer yard waste. Lumber, and other building material, & trash dumping is absolutely **NOT** permitted.

Using the dump is a privilege, not a right, and all dumping will end if Iowa Dept. of Natural Resources (DNR) and Amana Society rules on what may be dumped or the burning ban are violated.

If you witness violations of these rules, *please* report those abuses, to Amana Society Conservation at 319-213-3445.

Inspiring Reach for the Stars

The successful launch and docking in space of the manned mission, the Dragon SpaceX NASA joint venture, shines a bright light on the future and on the work of a Clear Creek Amana graduate, Joe Petrzelka.

Petrzelka is the Space X Dragon, director of engineering. Now living and working in Long Beach, California, (SpaceX's mission headquarters is in Hawthorne) Pretzelka grew up on a farm just north of High Amana. He attended Amana Elementary School, was a member of the Amana Achievers 4H Club along with his sister, and is a graduate of CCA. He graduated from Iowa State University with a degree in industrial and manufacturing systems engineering before attending MIT, the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. Jenna Petrzelka, his wife, is avionics production manager at SpaceX. A native of Annawan, Illinois, they have one son. She too is a graduate of Iowa State University, School of Engineering.

The company SpaceX is providing the transportation for two NASA astronauts in what scientists describe as a "self-driving car" a capsule and space craft that can fly to the space station, dock with it and return from it. It's propelled by a Falcon 9 rocket. The Falcon 9 itself is reusable as it drives itself back to earth, touches down and is retrieved for reuse in future. That entirely new technology will help make space travel possible in future.

Petrzelka was interviewed several times by national media last weekend, but for an indepth look at the project, the goals of the project and the work of his team, including interviews with key players in the Crew Dragon, at NASA and Pretzelka, look for the Science Channel, 90-minute documentary, "NASA and SpaceX: Journey to the Future." The show is available for free on the Science Channel website or App. It premiered March 25.

29TH ANNUAL ALLIS CHALMERS TRACTOR SHOW

The Allis Connection is pleased to announce the 29th Annual "All Allis" Fathers Day Show will take place on June 20th & 21st in the Amana Colonies.

"I am happy and proud to announce that The Allis Connection board of directors have decided that we will have the 29th annual Father's Day show at the Middle Amana Park, where it has been held for the past several years," said Mike Anderson, one of the organizers of the event. "Many other tractor events have cancelled this summer, and we are all very excited that this one will happen."

The event is the largest gathering of Allis Chalmers tractor in the area. Throughout the weekend there will be vendors, exhibits, and demonstrations at the park. Tours, rides, and a banquet are scheduled, and a tractor parade will be held at 1:00 PM Saturday and 1:00 PM Sunday. Anyone is welcome to visit the Middle Amana Park to view a wide variety of Allis Chalmers tractors or enjoy the parade.

The group has cancelled the pedal tractor pull for kids as an added precaution.

"We will do our best to offer a safe environment, and will have our microphone and speaker system to announce safety warnings and alerts. We also want everyone to bring their own personal face masks or coverings, as they will not be for sale on the grounds," Anderson said. "The Allis Connection is very thankful to the Governor of lowa for her efforts to reopen the state of lowa which has allowed us to continue our 29 years of uninterrupted celebration of Allis-Chalmers manufacturing and the people that drove them across this great State."

Allis Chalmers introduced their first tractor in 1914 and remained popular for generations before folding in 1985 due to the changing economic climate. Throughout their history Allis Chalmers had tractor and equipment plants throughout the Midwest, including one in Cedar Rapids at the site of what is now the Raining Rose production facility.
