Mr. Albouras asked about GTNA Board concerns. We discussed crime, police support, Neighborhood watch and traffic around the Exact Sciences development and how it might increase with a future expanded workforce population.

Mr. Matt Veldran updated the board:

- The Griffs Community Center project is progressing. It will open perhaps in late Spring as an education and mentoring center, not as a job placement center.
- The City Jail is being consolidated and the City Council is waiting for architect plans.
- The County is moving forward on plans to change the Alliant Energy Center complex but a source of funding is needed.
- The NIP (Neighborhood Intervention Program) has budgeted for 2 new staff members. They will be added soon.

The GTNA Annual meeting was discussed. It was agreed that the meeting has been well attended and provides valuable information for the neighborhood. Suggested topics:

- Appearance by the new Alder
- Report on Falk School from the PTA or the principal
- Appearance by a representative of the new West Side Police Station
- Possible update from the Stonehouse Development representatives
