## **TOWER REPORT**

## AIRPORT ENGINEER'S REPORT

Nik Ippolito appeared on behalf of the airport's engineering consultant, Gale Associates, Inc.

# CONSTRUCT ONLY - Pavement Maintenance Phase II (NHDOT No. SBG 12-21-2020)

This Project is to reconstruct taxilanes between hangars located on the north-west side of the Airfield (Runway 14 end.)

#### Project Status:

- This project is now substantially complete. The date of substantial completion was August 24, 2021. This will represent the start of the Contractor's 1-year guarantee.
- The Final inspection for this project was conducted on Wednesday September 1, 2021. There were minimal observations that require corrective actions.
- A Contract Amendment has been prepared to capture the cost of out-of-scope services that were rendered as part of this project. The amendment total is \$65,977.00 and consists of the following:
  - 1. CREDIT due to the Airport and to NHDOT/BA of \$6,238.00 for fees associated with Survey and Geotechnical services. (\$311.90 due back to the Airport, \$5,926.10 due back to NHDOT/BA)
  - 2. Fees for Gale's development and implementation of the Airport's Stormwater Pollution prevention Plan (SWPPP) and filing of a Notice of Intent under EPA's Multi Sector General Permit (\$18,243.00).

- 3. Fees for additional Construction Administration performed as part of the Contractor's additional work beyond the scope of the Project (\$16,015G).
- 4. Fees for additional Resident Engineering necessary to provide full time inspection services throughout the Project (\$41,675.00).

Because this grant was funded 100% by the FAA, the only financial impact resulting from this agreement will be the credit of \$311.90 received by the NAA. Upon execution of the agreement, Gale will provide the credit in the form of a check which the Authority will then use to credit both themselves, and the NHDOT/BA.

 Upon completion of punchlist work the final Reimbursement Request and project closeout documents will be processed.

## REHABILITATE TAXIWAY 'A' AND ASSOCIATED TAXIWAYS

This Project is for the design and construction phases necessary to rehabilitate Taxiway 'A', install new taxiway edge lighting (MITLs), and to address the grading issues at the intersection of Taxiway 'A' and Taxiway 'D'.

## Project Status:

• There is no update at this time, this Project has been placed on hold until the spring due to the grant timing and construction season.

## REHABILITATE GOLF RAMP AND FOXTROT RAMP

This project is for the design, and construction necessary to rehabilitate Golf and Foxtrot Ramps at the Airport.

- A scoping meeting was held on Thursday September 8, 2021 to coordinate the design effort
  necessary to administer this Project. From this meeting a draft Scope of Work has been prepared and
  submitted to NHDOT/BA and the Airport for review. Once review comments are received, Gale will
  prepare documents to assist the Airport in obtaining and Independent Fee Estimate for the project.
- Gale is coordinating with subconsultants to perform the necessary ground survey and geotechnical work necessary to support design of this Project.

#### **Recommended Actions:**

- Please review Gale's draft Scope of Work for this project and provide feedback.
- Please obtain and Independent Fee Estimate upon receipt of the Pro-forma.

#### **GENERAL ITEMS:**

Gale submitted a Notice of Intent for MSGP coverage, along with a Draft SWPPP via the EPA's
website on behalf of the Airport on 6/29/2021. A revision was made to the Airport's SWPPP on
8/20/2021, at which time the NOI was resubmitted for review. The target review date is 10/20/2021.
The Airport's 2015 MSGP coverage status is administratively continued until a new permit is issued
under the 2021 MSGP.
