



## School Related Travel over Spring Break March 12, 2020

Following expert guidance and as a preventative measure designed to limit exposure to locations with community spread of COVID-19, Bishop Kelley High School, Inc. and all other Diocese of Tulsa and Eastern Oklahoma Catholic preschools, elementary and middle schools have made the decision to cancel all school-sponsored domestic travel. This cancellation applies to all travel, regardless of travel method and includes out-of-state athletic activities. School sponsored non-essential professional travel is limited.

### Spring Break Travel Advisory

Any families/students/employees traveling during spring break should monitor CDC travel advisories and adhere to any recommended self quarantine as necessary. [The CDC recommends travelers, particularly those with underlying health issues, defer all cruise ship travel at this time.](#) Passengers on cruises during Spring Break are encouraged by the CDC to self-quarantine. Any member of our schools communities who makes the choice to travel to Europe must follow the self-quarantine guidelines.
