Charging Procedure

Follow these steps to charge the Model BP.

- 1. Connect the charger to the Model BP by inserting its output connector (Anderson) into the Anderson connector on the Model BP. Be certain both connections are fully engaged.
- 2. Plug the charger into a source of AC (90-240 VAC) using the supplied power cord.
- 3. The charger has a two LED lights that will come on while charging.

LED Indicators:

LED # 1 RED light ON means the charger is being powered by the proper AC voltage

LED #2 ORANGE colored light ON means the BP is in charging mode

LED # 2 GREEN colored light ON means the BP is fully charged and on "float charge"

THE CHARGER WILL AUTOMATICALLY SWITCH TO "FLOAT" MODE WHEN LEFT CONNECTED TO THE MODEL BP AFTER IT BECOMES FULLY CHARGED
