### MEMO FROM PASTOR MICHAEL



This cross-stitch is from the 18th century and presents an important theme in American history. Vines and fig trees are a Biblical image. For example, in Micah (4:3-4) we read:

And God shall judge among many people, and rebuke strong nations afar off; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks: nation shall not lift up a sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more. But they shall sit every man under his vine and under his fig tree; and none shall make them afraid . . .

American historian, Charles Royster writes that this biblical passage was among the most popular during the Revolutionary war, and the future hope of sitting unthreatened on one's farm, one of its most compelling images.

"Under their vine and fig tree" is a phrase often quoted by George Washington. He used it in his correspondence and there it can be found fifty times. First, Americans had to accept the misery of war. Then, they would lay down their weapons, pick up the plow, and after the harvest, rest unafraid, in the enjoyment with their families of the abundance they had made.

This simple needlework speaks to a deep human desire.


