

## September 6, 2022

The City Council of the City of New Munich met in regular session at 6:33 p.m., in the City Hall. Shawn Duevel, Elmer Boecker, Sandy Zierden, Kurt Thelen and Ron Doll were present.

On a motion by Ron Doll, seconded by Sandy Zierden and carried the minutes from August 1, 2022 were approved.

Fire Chief, Al Fiedler was present. On September 19 there will be a search and rescue training with Freeport and Melrose. The fire department currently has 14 members. Looking to put a banner up in front of the firehall to advertise for firefighters. Hydrants got flushed. Applied for a grant for a thermal imager. On September 28 there will be an electrical vehicle training. State Chiefs training will be in Duluth this year. Cost is \$1125.00 and the state will reimburse. Bills-MN fire certification Board \$240.00 and State Chiefs training \$1125.00.

Waste/Water Operator, Tom Valerius was present. Waste water-sampled in August for the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter. Companies were billed for water usage from road work. Water-magnesium results are in. Some new water meters were ordered. Well #6-wants to clean out again and maybe well #5. Sandy Zierden made a motion to clean/acid wash well #6. Elmer Boecker 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motioned carried. Meter was installed at 141 7<sup>th</sup> Ave E. Bills-Spee-dee and travel time. Tom gave notice that he is looking at being done by the end of the year. Will need to look into if we need to post the position or what rules the city needs to follow.
