Set -up time Saturday Morning 7 a.m. to 9 a.m.; site selection is assigned prior to the day for those vendors that have contacted the designated person of the San Jacinto County Historical Commission (SJCHC). booth spaces are 12'X20'. the license fee per event is \$30.00 per space. Food vendors' license fee is \$50.00 per space. In addition, food vendors must maintain a copy of their products liability/health certificate on site and submit a copy for SJCHC files. Trades Day event ends at dark.

Vendors are encouraged to bring and set-up canopies for their assigned site. Vendors may not use bungee cords or drive stakes into the courthouse grounds. Tables/booths shall not infringe upon or damage Courthouse flower beds or plantings. Vendors will be held liable for any damages to the property or grounds. The SJCHC is in charge of the Courthouse grounds during this event and vendors must comply with requests and directions of the SJCHC . Vendors are prohibited from engaging in any unlawful activity or any other activity that constitutes a nuisance. Violations may result in immediate removal without refund.

The SJCHC and vendor agree that San Jacinto County, the SJCHC, their officers and members shall in no case be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to Vendor, their agents, servants, family, or employees, regardless of cause.

The SJCHC and Vendor further agrees that Vendor shall defend, indemnify and hold San Jacinto County, the SJCHC, their officers and members harmless from and against any and all actions, costs, claims, losses, expenses and/or damages sustained by San Jacinto County, the SJCHC, their officers and members attributable to recklessness or negligence of Vendor or any of it's agents, damage and/or injury or death to any person or persons.
