President Lilla Hewitt called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

Minutes – The minutes from the August 16th meeting were approved as presented.

Treasurer's Report – Linda presented the Treasurer's Report, on file. It was noted that we have had good income from entry fees for events and also several new memberships.

Old Business -

<u>Dressage/Pleasure Driving Show in 2018 at Paso Robles Horse Park</u> – Diane Kastama put together a list of ideas and suggestions which were reviewed at the last meeting. To recap, Diane would serve as Show Chairman with the provision that it be set up as a charity horse-show to benefit USDFD, which was approved at the last meeting. She will schedule a meeting with Amanda at the Horse Park to get final quotes on fees. Possible dates are the end of March or early April. May is not available at the Horse Park.

Aleks, Volunteer Coordinator, presented several ideas for the volunteers: getting t-shirts with the name of the show embroidered on each, possibly getting reflective vests to identify show volunteers, a tote bag with food and water for helpers, setting up specific people to make sure judges and other officials have what they need, etc.

It was agreed that October 15 & 16 would work (a Sunday and Monday). This would be informal, people could either ride or drive or simply lead their animals around at halter. Volunteers to help set up would be very much appreciated.

<u>February 16-18 – Clinic with Larry Brinker</u> – Diane reported that Larry will be judging the Sweetheart ADT, then the Continuous Drive in Fresno, and that he would have time to give dressage lessons here before returning home. We were asked by CVHA to share in Larry's travel expenses. There was considerable interest in having Larry here and it was agreed that we could charge \$80/lesson which would cover our share of his air travel expenses. M/S/C that we schedule Larry Brinker to give lessons here in North and/or South County and that we will be responsible to pay \$200 to CVHA as our share of expenses.


