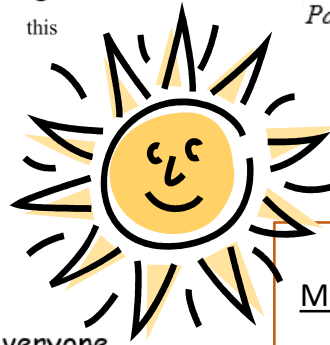


There Was a Little Man
