Cassia Replacement: Milky Way, a warm season white flower blooming tree was placed between Bldg 22 and 23 completing the replacement of Cassia.

Entrance: Additional Egg Rock was placed where needed at entrance.

Replacement Planting: Spring review of plant replacement needs completed with our landscape contractors. Plants will be placed to take advantage of the rainy season.

Irrigation: A couple of irrigation heads popped, causing minor "gushers". The quick response by our landscape contractor is appreciated. Fourteen (14) Irrigation control box covers and water shut off box covers were replaced. Irrigation riser replacement on building side and lanai area continues. Irrigation wet check will be completed before the end of May.

Outside Lighting: Volunteer Stan Mohn realigned the Saratoga Boulevard landscape lighting, replaced lamps, fixed a fault in the wiring, replaced the electric eye for the lights at the entrance, replaced building light bulbs, as well as an outside receptacle (Building 22). Thank you Stan.
