I had a work accident on September 11, 2000 of which a result I was left disabled and not been able to do my work 100%, I was fired in January 4, 2001.

I took my claim to the Industrial Division, Mrs. Luisa Carpenelli conducted the investigation, and was ordered by **S & C Claims Services, Inc.** to reestablish my rights, order was given on March 14, 2001 but wasn't followed by the following reason:

Letter March 23, 2001 soliciting the Director Roger Bremner to close my case petitioned by the Legal Offices of **Gugino & Schwartz**. And the response was positive in the letter dated April 17, 2001.

The order of the agency given in my favor wasn't accepted, but the petition to close my case was accepted; since then I have been looking for help trying to find a solution to my case, even the Senator Harry Reid wrote a letter to the offices of the governor 8 months ago, requesting a solution to my case, (Please, also find it attached).
In the courts, I haven't been able to win my case, eventhough all of the doctor's opinions are that I need urgent care, (Please see copy of MRI report).

I decided to write to you looking for your support, because I read the article in the Nevada Appeal Archives dated October 27, 2005 where Director Roger Bremner was mentioned.

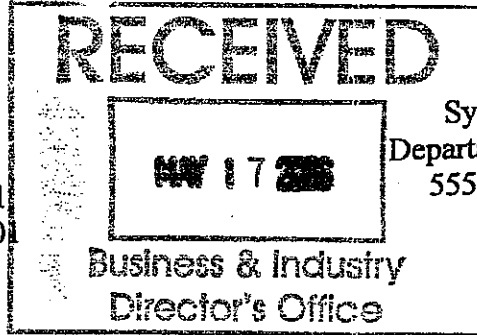
I am attaching all of the documents, that proof everything I have talked about in this letter.

REQUEST FOR INVESTIGATION AND SOLUTION

Dear Ms. Director,

I had a wok related accident on September 11, 2000 of which a result I was left disabled and not able to fulfill my job duties to the fullest. I was fired in January 24, 2001.

I took my claim to the DIVISION RELATIONS INSURANCE, the agency which you direct. Mrs. Luisa Carpenelli conducted the investigation and was ordered by S & C Claims Services, Inc. to reestablish my rights. The order was given on March 12, 2001 (please see attached for complete letter) but was not followed through for the following reason: The letter dated March 23, 2001 from the Legal Offices of Gugino & Schwartz directed to the Administrator Roger Bremner said the following "Since Ms. Carpanlli has no legitimate authority for her position, I request that you (a) retract her letter and (b) formally investigate her actions" (please see attached). The response to this later was dated April 17, 2001 and said the following: "Therefore, the determination letter of March 12, 2001 is rescinded. The notice of correction issued in that determination is dismissed with no plan of corrective action required" (please see attached).

I ask myself how it is possible that the State of Nevada can uphold something of this sort when this agency is formed to help the injured rather than to deal with outside politics. This has destroyed my life. My family fell apart as I could no longer sustain the position of being the head of my household, caring for my children and wife. I have suffered extreme hardships not being able to have access to doctors for a full and complete recovery of my disability. I have endured excruciating pain and stress, lost my family, work and self-worth all as a result of the accident I suffered on September 11, 2000.

For these reasons I am requesting your intervention to investigate why DRI acted in this matter. I will be attentively waiting on your response and resolution to my issue. Otherwise, I will have to pursue other methods, including public means, to resolve my dilemma and show to others how the State of Nevada manage the claims of injured-workers.
