PARMA TOWNSHIP BOARD REGULAR MEETING  
MARCH 11, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chamberlain in the Township Hall, 16407 Comdon Road, Albion, MI. The pledge to the flag followed. Present: Chamberlain, Spangler, Dermyer, Mohney, Engelter, Boehlke, Deputy Vosters and several observers.

Deputy Vosters reported on incidents handled by the Sheriffs' department in February.

Board Regular meeting minutes from February 11, 2019 and Board Special meeting minutes from February 20, 2019 were entered into the records as presented.

Dermyer gave the treasurer's report. Fund balances as of February 28, 2019 were as follows: General \$255,582.21; Water \$70,727.11 and CP Federal Savings \$348.00. Dermyer has settled 2018 taxes with the County and everything went well.

Commissioner Bair reported on happenings at the County.

Engelter gave the fire report. Total fire department assets are \$1,041,462.25. Expense total for the month is \$12,840.63. There were 48 runs in February.

Announcements included the March Board of Review will be March 13 from 1 to 4 and 6 to 9 and March 15 from 9 to 12 and 1 to 4.

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OLD BUSINESS:

Decisions regarding a Lighting District in Amberton Village were postponed until March.

Chamberlain moved Mohny seconded carried to readopt Liquor License 2009-5 and rename it to 2009-10 because of a numbering conflict. Chamberlain yes, Mohny yes, Dermeyer yes, Spangler yes, Engelter yes.

Chamberlain asked for a report from the ad hoc committee regarding the Amberton Village Capital Re-placement plan. Engelter said they had not yet met, but would as soon as there is a break in the weather.

#### NEW BUSINESS:

Setting a fee for large gatherings was postponed until March.

Chamberlain moved Dermeyer seconded carried to amend the fee schedule to include marihuana renewal fees of \$5,000 and reduce the marihuana renewal fee to \$1,500 if a certificate of occupancy has not been issued by the time of renewal.
