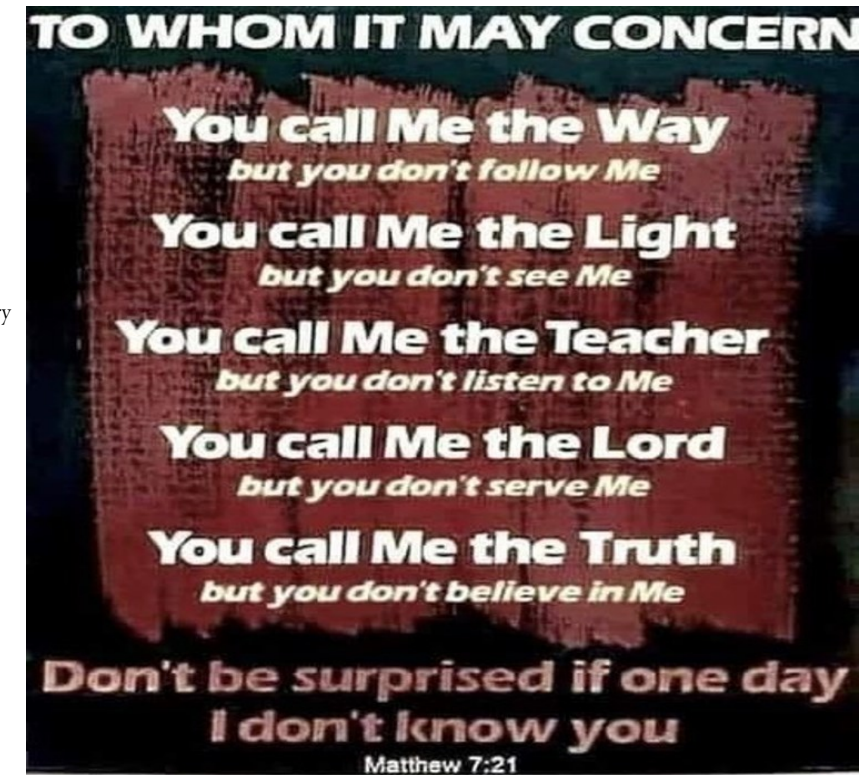

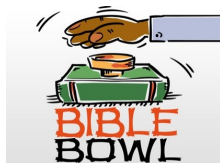

A WORD ABOUT BIBLE BOWL

The Bible Bowl study for this year covers Paul's first two missionary journeys (Acts 3-18). These are only 6 chapters, but cover an enormous amount of information.

Parents, please know, that by studying with your children at home, (not just Bible Bowl) you are teaching them vitally important values.

- (1) That Christianity is at the top of your priority list. Children will eventually determine whether electronic devices, sports, or other activities take precedence over spiritual activities, and will likely copy the same pattern in their own lives.
- (2) That God's word has relevance. As you go through the study, ask, "What lesson can we get from this?" If our children know that scripture has an integral part in their life, they will be more apt to be interested in it.
- (3) That they are obeying God's word by studying and growing (2 Tim. 2:15; 2 Pet. 3:7).
