CLAIMS BAR DATE NOTICE

TO: ALL PERSONS OR ENTITIES THAT INVESTED FUNDS WITH MANTRIA CORPORATION OR ITS AFFILIATES, WERE EMPLOYED BY MANTRIA CORPORATION OR ITS AFFILIATES, OR WHO ARE CREDITORS OF MANTRIA CORPORATION OR ITS AFFILIATES

PLEASE READ THIS ENTIRE NOTICE CAREFULLY. YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS MAY BE AFFECTED BY THE ABOVE-CAPTIONED LAWSUIT IN THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT FOR THE DISTRICT OF COLORADO. THIS NOTICE ADVISES YOU OF YOUR RIGHT TO ASSERT A CLAIM AGAINST THE RECEIVERSHIP ESTATE, DESCRIBED MORE FULLY BELOW.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that by Order dated September 27, 2016, the United States District Court for the District of Colorado (the "Court") has fixed midnight Mountain Standard Time on January 2, 2017 (the "Claims Bar Date") as the deadline for all persons and entities, including but not limited to, individuals, partnerships, corporations, estates, governmental units, unions, trusts and trustees who have or assert, or believe they may have or assert, any Claim (as defined below) to have submitted in the manner described below, and the Receiver to have actually received, a formal claim against funds currently being held in the registry of the Court (the "Receivership Estate"). The Claims Bar Date and the procedures for filing a Claim apply to all Claims by investors that arose on or before November 16, 2009.

ALL PERSONS OR ENTITIES THAT FAIL TO ASSERT A CLAIM THAT AROSE FROM INVESTING IN MANTRIA CORPORATION, INC. ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 16 2009, WHETHER LIQUIDATED OR UNLIQUIDATED, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS CLAIMS BAR DATE NOTICE MAY BE FOREVER BARRED, ESTOPPED AND ENJOINED FROM ASSERTING A CLAIM AGAINST THE RECEIVERSHIP ESTATE AND MAY NOT BE ELIGIBLE TO SHARE IN ANY DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS FROM THE RECEIVERSHIP ESTATE.

1. **WHAT THIS LAWSUIT IS ABOUT.** On or about November 16, 2009, the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") filed this civil action against the Defendants for operating a fraudulent investment scheme. The Court entered a temporary restraining order and asset freeze on December 2, 2009, which was converted to a permanent injunction on December 16, 2009. On April 30, 2010, John Paul Anderson, a Director at Alvarez & Marsal Dispute Analysis & Forensic Services, LLC, was appointed as Receiver by The Honorable Judge Christine M. Arguello of the United States District Court for the District of Colorado ("the Court"). IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS FROM THE RECEIVERSHIP ESTATE, YOU MUST SUBMIT A FORMAL PROOF OF CLAIM FORM TO THE RECEIVER IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS CLAIMS BAR DATE NOTICE. YOU ARE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A PROOF OF CLAIM FORM EVEN IF YOU PREVIOUSLY REGISTERED WITH THE RECEIVER, OR SUBMITTED A CLAIM OR OTHER INFORMATION TO THE RECEIVER, THE SEC, OR THE FBI.

2. **WHAT IS A CLAIM.** As used in this Claims Bar Date Notice, "Claim" shall be broadly defined to include any right to payment, whether or not such right is reduced to judgment, is liquidated or unliquidated, is fixed or contingent, is matured or unmatured, is disputed or undisputed, is legal or equitable, or is secured or unsecured, existing on or before of November 16, 2009. The term "Claim" also includes any right to an equitable remedy for a breach of performance which gives rise to a right to payment, whether or not such right is reduced to judgment, is fixed or contingent, is matured or unmatured, is disputed or undisputed, or is **secured or unsecured.**

3. **WHO IS AN ELIGIBLE CLAIMANT.** As used in this Claims Bar Date Notice, "Eligible Claimants" is defined in the Motion for Order Setting Procedures and Deadlines for Filing Claims.

4. **WHO MUST SUBMIT A CLAIM. YOU MUST SUBMIT A PROOF OF CLAIM FORM.** If you have a Claim against any of the Defendants, arising from an investment in Mantria Corporation, and you desire to share in any distribution from the Receivership Estate, the Receiver must receive your Proof of Claim Form on or before the Claims Bar Date. You are required to submit a Proof of Claim Form to the Receiver, even if you

previously submitted a Claim or other information to the Receiver, the SEC, the FBI, or other law enforcement officials.

5. **CLAIMANTS WITH PENDING ACTIONS AGAINST DEFENDANTS.** Any person or entity who has an action pending against any of the Defendants shall not be permitted to file a Claim against the Receivership Estate unless and until either (1) such pending action has been dismissed without prejudice and a certified copy of the order of dismissal is included with the Claim, or (2) such action has been prosecuted to a judgment on or before the Claims Bar Date that may then be filed as a Claim against the Receivership Estate.

6. **WHEN AND WHERE TO FILE YOUR CLAIM.** The Receiver must actually receive, on or before midnight Mountain Standard Time on January 2, 2017, an official Proof of Claim Form from any person or entity who wishes to assert a Claim and share in any distribution from the Receivership Estate. You may submit your Proof of Claim Form electronically at the Receiver's website,

To be timely filed, your Claim must be RECEIVED by the Receiver on or before midnight Mountain Standard Time on January 2, 2017, the Claims Bar Date.

CLAIMS MAY NOT BE FILED BY FACSIMILE TRANSMISSION OR TELECOPIER AND ANY CLAIMS SUBMITTED BY SUCH METHODS SHALL NOT BE CONSIDERED TO BE VALIDLY FILED CLAIMS.

7. **WHAT TO FILE.** Each Claim must be submitted on an official Proof of Claim Form, which can be obtained at the Receiver's website,

or by writing to the Receiver at the above address. All Claims must be filed in the English language and all monetary amounts claimed must be stated in the lawful currency of the United States. The Receiver, in its discretion, may also require any Eligible Claimant to provide documentary evidence supporting his/her/its Claim. The submission of a Claim shall be deemed to be the sworn declaration of the person submitting the claim under penalty of perjury, in accordance with the laws of the United States of America.

ANY POTENTIALLY ELIGIBLE CLAIMANT WHO FAILS TO FILE A CLAIM SO THAT IT IS ACTUALLY RECEIVED BY THE RECEIVER ON OR BEFORE THE CLAIMS BAR DATE, MAY BE FOREVER BARRED, ESTOPPED AND ENJOINED FROM ASSERTING SUCH CLAIM AGAINST THE RECEIVERSHIP ESTATE AND MAY NOT SHARE IN ANY DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS FROM THE RECEIVERSHIP ESTATE.
