Viburnum

This tough, beautiful Native shrub is great for just about anywhere. The bright glossy leaves, showy flowers and stunning Fall color make this a great specimen for the landscape. This Viburnum, as with most, has a high wildlife value. Many different species of birds feed on the fruit and the flowers are an important nectar source for butterflies and insects. The fruit is also edible for humans either raw or cooked. A tea made from the bark is known to be medicinal.

Viburnum nudum

- Hardiness: Zone 5-9
- Size: 5-15'
- Habit: Multi-stemmed upright, rounded. Medium growth rate
- Flower: White, late spring, showy
- Fruit: Late summer from green to bright pink to blue and purple. Showy
- Culture: Prefers well-drained, moist soil and Sun to partial shade. Adaptable, will tolerate wet, compacted soils
- Uses: Specimen, hedge, naturalizing, wet areas, fall color, wildlife, edible, medicinal
