Feb. 16 / '99

-P.A.R.C. gives approval in principle and forwards it to L.C. Council.

-"Citizens Voice" committee announces approval of our proposal.

May 13/ '99

-Council gives approval in principle.

June 15/ '99

- General meeting at George Elliott Community School. Highlights, - Steering Committee disbanded

- new members came on board,

Jan. 2000,
