MINISTRY OF HOSPITALITY

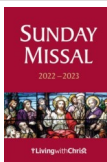
Parishioners are asked to consider volunteering for the Ministry of Hospitality during the summer. A few new members would make scheduling a little easier.

HEARING ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY

St Joseph's Church has an FM System installed which will allow those with hearing challenges to use the system in order to improve their ability to hear the readings and prayers.

In order to use the system, you will need to obtain an FM receiver and either a headset or hearing loop from the Hospitality Ministry, when you enter the church. As we have limited numbers they will be issued on a first come basis.

To use the headset, plug it into the receiver and adjust the volume to a comfortable level.

To be able to use the hearing loop, you must have hearing aids that have a T-coil, and it needs to be activated by your hearing care professional if it is not. To determine whether you have T-coil or not, the model number for the hearing aids that have a T-coil installed will end with a T.

The units must be returned immediately following the liturgy.

JUNE 13 - MEMORIAL OF SAINT ANTHONY OF PADUA, PRIEST, DOCTOR: Although Anthony came from Portugal, the city of Padua in Italy claims him as its own. Born in 1195, he joined the Canons Regular of Saint Augustine, becoming an accomplished biblical scholar. His contact with some Franciscans who were later martyred inspired him to move to the Franciscans. Illness prevented mission work and he was sent to Italy where, having led a hidden life, he was ordered to fill in for an absent preacher. The immediate result was the discovery of his great oratorical gifts and he was sent by Francis to preach and to teach his fellow friars throughout northern Italy. The power of his words converted numerous people. Exhausted and ill, he died at the age of 36, so beloved and revered that he was canonized within the year. Saint Anthony of Padua is best known for his help in finding lost objects.

JUNE 16 - SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS: In the devotion to the Sacred Heart, the heart of Jesus is adored as a symbol of his threefold love: human love, spiritual love, and divine love. In modern times, the image of the Sacred Heart in the home has become a sign that the love of Jesus rules over the family. In 1899, Pope Leo XIII consecrated the world to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

JUNE 16 - WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE SANCTIFICATION OF PRIESTS: This day, which coincides with the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, was begun by Pope John Paul II in 2002, with the objective of having all Catholic faithful join in prayer for the sanctification of Priests. Please set aside some time on this special day to pray for Priests throughout the world, that they may dwell "in the heart of Jesus".

JUNE 17 - MEMORIAL OF THE IMMACULATE HEART OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY: The devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary is closely linked with that to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. On numerous occasions, Popes have consecrated the whole world to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Mary's sanctity and her love as the Mother of God are signified by her immaculate heart. In the Act of Consecration to the Heart of Mary, all that one is and has is entrusted to her.
