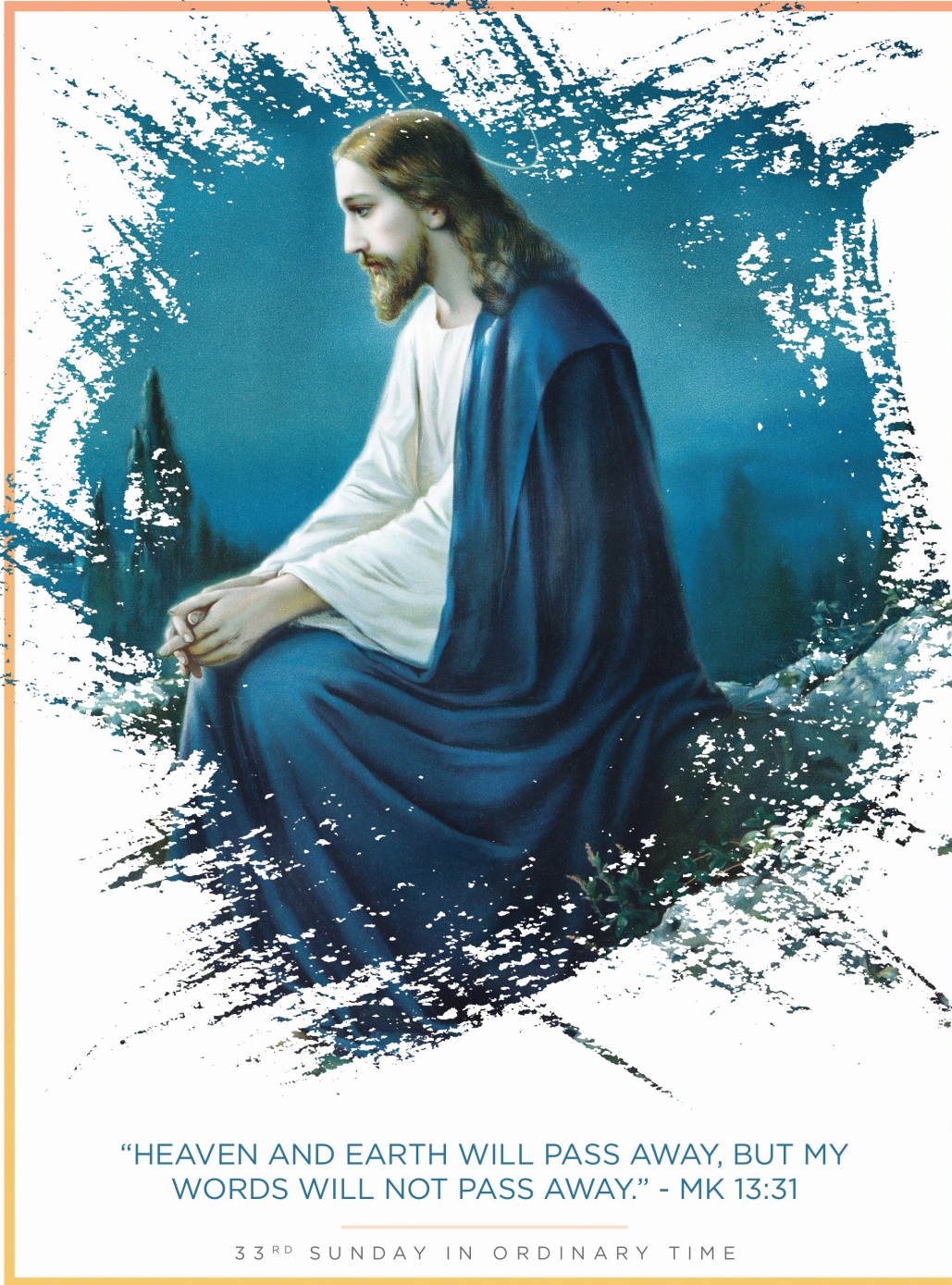

Our Lady of Chiquinquirá

Our Lady of Chiquinquirá has two feast days! July 9 and November 18. She is also known as “La Chinita” or “Our Lady of the Rosary of Chiquinquirá”. This is a well-known title for Our Lady from Latin America, and she is the patroness of Colombia and Venezuela. So what is her story?

In the country of Colombia there was an image of her painted in a chapel. Overtime it became faded and was put away. A lady was cleaning and discovered the painting and rehung it in the church. Miraculously the day after Christmas the painting was restored to its original brilliant colors!

In Venezuela a woman was washing clothes by the river and saw a wooden board floating in the water. Thinking it could be useful she brought it home with her. Later she heard a knocking sound come from the wood. When she looked there was a faint image of our Lady on the board! She hung it on her wall and later heard more knocking and when she looked again the image now had color and more detail. What an amazing miracle.

THE MORE YOU KNOW

Veterans Day is a day to commemorate veterans of all wars. Every Veterans Day and Memorial Day, Arlington National Cemetery holds an annual memorial service. The cemetery is home to the graves of over 400,000 people, most of whom served in the military. The military men and women who serve and protect the United States come from all walks of life; they are parents, children, grandparents, friends, neighbors and coworkers, and are an important part of their communities. Here are some facts about the veteran population of the United States:

- 19 million living veterans served during at least one war as of April 2021.
- 11 percent of veterans are women.
- 5.9 million veterans served during the Vietnam War.
- 7.8 million veterans served in the Gulf War era.
- Of the 16 million Americans who served during World War II, about 240,000 were still alive as of 2021.
- 933,000 veterans served during the Korean War.
- As of 2021, the top three states with the highest percentage of Veterans were Alaska, Virginia and Montana.

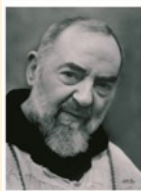
