## **GUIDELINES FOR TIGA SCHOLARSHIP:**

To be eligible to apply for the scholarship you must meet the following criteria:

- The scholarship can be awarded to a graduating senior who plans to pursue a college degree with an agricultural major or a current college student that is currently pursuing an agricultural major.
- The applicant must enroll in a college or university in Texas. •
- The scholarship is made available to immediate family of customers of TIGA member gins, employees and immediate family of employees of TIGA member gins, and immediate family of owners/managers of TIGA member gins.
  - A gin is considered a TIGA member gin if the gin is current with their dues and declared in good standing by the association.
  - Immediate family is defined as husband, wife, children and grandchildren.
- In addition, the scholarship is made available to immediate family of employees of TIGA associate members, employees and immediate family of owners/managers of the member business.
  - A business is considered a TIGA associate member if the business is current with their dues and declared in good standing by the association.
  - Immediate family is defined as husband, wife, children and grandchildren.
- If you apply for the TIGA scholarship and are not selected for that year, you may re-apply the following year. However, once you have been selected as a recipient you are no longer eligible to apply.
- Once you have been notified that you are a recipient of the TIGA scholarship it is your responsibility to send a copy of your transcript to the association office. The transcript should include the following information:
  - The name and address of the school in which you are enrolled
  - The major you have declared
  - All courses you are enrolled in for the upcoming or current semester
  - A current photo used for promotional material for TIGA purposes and displayed on the TIGA website
- Once you have been notified that you are a recipient you have a twelvemonth time period from the date on the TIGA letter to request the money. After the twelve-month time period has elapsed, you will forfeit the right to the scholarship and the monies will be returned to the scholarship fund. It is your responsibility to request the money. The association will not notify you of the upcoming twelve-month deadline.
