## Armed and Dangerous (holy, justified, and faithful)

## Romans 1:16-17

- I.) "Breastplate of righteousness" Eph. 6:10-14
  - A.) Breastplate covers the chest or "area of the "heart"

**Prov 4:23** Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.

You must protect your heart, it is where we are justified. Romans 10:5-13

- B.) Righteousness: Greek= dikaiosune *dik-ah-yos-oo-nay*. Equitable, innocent, holy. Just, meet, right.
- C.) This righteousness comes from God alone! Isa 59:15-17
- II.) We need <u>his</u> righteousness to make <u>us</u> holy.
  - A.)We can't see him without holiness. Hebrews 12:14-17
  - B.)We have no righteousness outside of Christ. II Corinthians 5:16-21
- III.) Righteousness is a sign of our faith, proving that we are justified against sin.
  - A.) Like Abraham we are justified by faith, but righteous through our actions. James 2:21-24
  - B.) The righteous will be remembered

PS 112:6 Surely he will never be shaken;

- a righteous man will be remembered forever.
- C.) Through righteousness we will be faithful will be rewarded, we will trade in the breastplate for a crown.
- **II Tim.4:6** For I am now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand.
- **7** I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith:
  - **8** Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.
