# 2014 RMMC Fall Colors Tour Details

We will be making a southern swing this year to view the fall changing of the colors here in Southern Colorado. Drive time is estimated at 2 hours which includes a 15 minute break halfway along the way.

The RMMC Fall Colors tour will start at the parking lot of the Safeway located at 1920 S. Nevada Ave COS 80905. We will gather there starting at 8:30 AM, assemble the caravan and head south on CO 115 to Canon City at 9:00 AM. We will stop at the McDonalds at 2305 Fremont Drive in Canon City 81212 for a bathroom and drink break for 15-20 minutes. We will then head back out onto CO 115 going thru Canon City and head toward CO 9 North to start our trip thru the forested valley toward our final destination at Mark and Polly's house at 149 Cherokee Pl in Florissant CO 80816. The roads are all paved save for the last mile or so getting back to Mark and Polly's house which is a gravel road. Lunch will be had be all and we can all check out Mark's Mustang collection, bench race and view interesting artifacts Mark collected during his tenure working for the Ford Motor Company. Expected arrival is at 11:00 – 11:30 AM at the Robert's home depending on traffic conditions and weather along the route.






