

DAVID L. BEAVER, Elkton—

Mr. Beaver, 50, barber, civic leader and World War II veteran, died unexpectedly Tuesday noon at his home. He was born June 13, 1913, in Elkton and spent most of his lifetime here. He and Miss Veronica Seaman were married Jan. 27, 1939, in Detroit. He served in 1945 in the U.S. Navy. He was a member of the Elkton Lions Club and Jean American Legion Post of Caseville. He was a trustee the last two years of the village council and was re-elected March 9 for two years. He was a barber in Elkton since 1947. Surviving are his widow; two daughters, Mrs. Dan McGee, Utica, and Miss Christine Beaver, Lansing; a son, Peter, Lansing; a grandchild; his mother, Mrs. Naomi Beaver, Battle Creek; two brothers, Edward, Dearborn, and Clifton, Battle Creek; and a sister, Mrs. Shelby Minter, Battle Creek. Requiem mass will be solemnized at 9:30 a.m. Monday in St. Francis Borgia Catholic Church in Pigeon by the Rev. Fr. Glenn William Cronkite. Burial will be in Grandlawn Cemetery at Pigeon.
