BIKES FOR BOOKS

Bikes For Books is a reading incentive program created by the Masons for students in elementary school, grades K-8th. The reading Incentive program was created to support literacy in our schools. John Shorter, from Kingman, contacted Cedar Hills School and under the direction of The Masonic Lodge will be sponsoring this program.

The Bikes For Books program is very simple. Each student is asked to read as many books as they can from Monday, February 7th through May 5th, 2022. Students will complete a tally form for every book they read. The forms will be provided to each student. The more books they read, the greater chance they have to win a new bike and helmet. The more books read, the more entries you receive. Books chosen must be appropriate for each student's grade level. If a book exceeds 100 pgs., the student will receive 2 raffle entries. The school will be raffling the bikes/helmets at a date to be announced in May, 2022.

The Masonic Lodge will be raffling off 2 brand new bikes with helmets. In support of our literacy program, Hackberry Elementary School District #3 will match the Masonic Lodge. Which means, there will be an additional 2 bikes with helmets provided for students to earn by reading books.
