Dear Brothers and Sisters, We all are a part of Christ's Church. Members of the Church founded by Christ 2000 years ago. It is not an individual experience but a communal experience. The Knights are an example of community. The Mass is the focus of the community, the supreme act of Faith and Worship. We gather each week summoned by Jesus at Mass. We first process in led by the Cross of Christ and the Gospels. Beginning with the Introductory Rites: Greeting: We make the Sign of the Cross the community responds with Amen. And the priest of God by his ordination calls down the Holy Spirit in word and gesture. Extending his Consecrated hands says one of three choices like 'The Lord be with you. The community answers with the words only 'And with Your Spirit', acknowledging that by his ordination the Holy Spirit be ever present in the priest. The priest then may briefly introduce the Mass in his own words. Penitential Rite: As a community we then acknowledge with the Confiteor our need for forgiveness and Mercy with the Kyrie; Lord have Mercy and Christ have Mercy. We then sing the Gloria, glorifying God. Not done in Advent or Lent as they are penitential seasons and we are more subdued. The priest finishes with the Collect, the prayer to prepare us for the Liturgy of the Word. Here we listen, as St. Paul's says we believe in our hearing the Word of God. The first reading and Psalm are from the Old Testament the original Jewish Scripture. First except in the Easter season when we use the St. Luke's Acts of the Apostles. Following the Psalm will be an epistle from the Saints Paul and Peter and others. Then the Gospel, this year we use mostly the Gospel of Matthew. Please listen and hear how the first reading is related to the Gospel. To be continued: God Bless; Fr. Grace

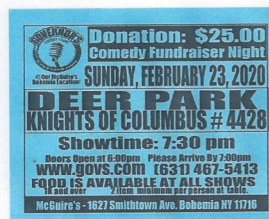
