Welcome to our 'Horse Game Show'. We are new rider friendly as we cater to the inexperienced riders. This is where you start. As long as your horse is reasonably safe to ride, you are welcome here.

Our events are all set-up so beginners can complete all the events. Don't be timid as you will find that most of the experienced riders are willing to give help and advice.

We run the classes with the oldest age groups first so younger riders can see it done several times before their ride is up. With the one event that has a "jump" in it, the rider has the option of just having the jump laying on the ground and to just walk your horse over it.

Some new show goers make the mistake of thinking their horse has to be good enough to win before going to their first show. Horses need show experience to get good at it just like people. You get experience by going to shows or even lots of shows.

Remember you have a horse to have fun with it! If you happen to win once and a while that's great! But you have to have fun first! If you have questions don't be afraid to call us, but remember the day of the show we are pretty busy.

Ages 20 and Under – Both Riders on the team will get a cold bottle of pop. They will exchange the bottles at the far end of the arena and return across the timeline. If they don't drop the bottle of pop it is theirs to keep! NOTE: Due to "Time Restraints" Riders may only ride ONCE.

RING RACE [Only if Time Permits]

35 & Over / 18-34 / 14-17 / 11-13 / 10 & Under [DEPENDING on TIME...A Figure 8 Race may be added here.]

BARRELS [To Start at 2:00 p.m.]

35 & Over / 18-34 / 14-17 / 11-13 / 10 & Under

NOTE: All riders who wear a safety helmet in each class entered will have their name entered into 2 separate age group drawings: 17 & Under; 18 & Over.

<u>RULES-COWBOY DRESS CODE</u>: Western Hat or Helmet must be worn, (We strongly recommend all riders wear helmets). Button down <u>Western Shirt</u> (long or short sleeves), Jeans/Riding Pants or Riding Skirt, and <u>Western Riding Boots</u> must be worn. Vests and ties welcome.

High Point Awards! Custom Belt Buckles will be given out to 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place in each age group. Buckles will be awarded to Horse and Rider at the Saturday Night Rodeo Performance. NOTE: Participation in the Rodeo Awards Ceremony is REQUIRED to receive a buckle. Also note that the Cowboy Dress Code is REQUIRED to be in a PRCA Rodeo Arena. Since the High Point Winners are participating in a PRCA Program, the riders are expected to ride in the Grand Entrance with the Cowboys and Cowgirls at the beginning of the performance (dress code enforced).

I HEREBY WAIVE AND RELEASE THE S.F.B.C. LLC., CITY OF STANLEY, AND THE ARENA FROM ALL LIABILITY OF ANY NATURE FOR INJURY, DAMAGE OR TRANSMITTABLE DISEASE, WHICH I AND MY HORSE MAY SUFFER. RODEO GAME RULES

- A Horse may be used only once in any event.
- No running through the gate at the start or finish of an event.
- Lead line riders will receive one participation ribbon for the day.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed in staging area or stands.
- Other than "lead line" there can be NO physical presence or help past the time line.
- The next rider must be in the "in chute" when his/her name is called or the next rider will be called... ("in the hole" name will be called prior).
- At the judges' discretion, a rider may be disqualified for horse abuse, unsportsmanlike conduct (including foul language), lack of control or unsafe situation such as an unruly horse.
- A rider may request that a jump be laid on the ground with 5 seconds added to their time.
- No whipping or spurring in front of the cinch.
- A Western Hat or helmet must be worn (we strongly recommend all riders wear helmets).
- Button down western shirts (Long or short sleeves), jeans/riding pants or riding skirt, and western riding boots with at least a ½ inch heal must be worn. Vest or ties are welcome.
- One (1) second penalty for losing hat if it falls to the ground within the gates.
- No re-rides for broken equipment or fallen horses. No re-ride due to equipment failure if the time clock has started.
- Entry period ends one event prior.
- High point ties will be broken by the barrel's event.
- In the event of ties for the class, the tie is to be run off between the riders involved the winner of the tie must have ran-off within two (2) seconds of his/her original time or the run-off must be held again. OPTIONAL: if both riders agree, the tie will be broken by the flip of a coin.
- Any breaking of the pattern means disqualification. Circling of the props more than once, backing, changing of direction, etc. is not considered breaking of pattern as the time will take care of that.
- No running your horse in the staging area, there is a Sand warm up area in the parking lot.
- Any act of discourtesy or disobedience towards any Rodeo Game Official or Worker, in or out of the arena, will result in disqualification for the duration of the Rodeo Game Show.
- Any grievance must be submitted in writing to the judge and may not be discussed with the volunteers/workers in the announcer's stand.
- If the timer fails, the rider has an option of two re-rides. If more obstacles are knocked over on the first re-ride then the initial ride then a second re-ride can be taken with the later time used.
