



## **URGENT ANNOUNCEMENT**

### **LINDMORE IRRIGATION DISTRICT GROWERS**

**Water Availability:** Conditions in the San Joaquin River watershed have become more favorable. As such, LID is announcing unlimited use of water for irrigation and/or recharge on your land. This condition is likely to exist at least through February 28, 2023. The price of this water will remain at \$212.00 per acre foot.

**District System:** Due to challenges on the District's 70+ year old system, there will be alternating outages on lines depending on the main line as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> Avenue (accounts beginning with a #1 – 88.4 Line) will be off until February 1 for repair and recharge.

5<sup>th</sup> Avenue (accounts beginning with a #3 – 90.4 Line) will be available until January 28 and then off till April 1.

10<sup>th</sup> East and West/West Pump (accounts beginning with #'s 5, 7, 8 and 9 – 93.2 Line) will be off until February 1 for repair.

**These outage times may change depending on weather conditions. Due to the heavy rains, the lines cannot be repaired because it poses a danger to both the maintenance crew and the system.**

**Recharge Operations:** New Policy – all water delivered through an LID meter to a landowner's property will be reported to the East Kaweah GSA on a regular basis. Therefore, it is not necessary for a landowner to identify whether water delivered through an LID meter is delivered to their property for recharge or irrigation. LID will report the amount delivered to the property and the EKGSA will view all Evapotranspiration (ET) from that property. If the amount of water delivered is greater than the amount removed through ET, there will be a credit (positive balance) on that landowners Kaweah Dashboard Account.
