

Kundinger, Gerhard W.

Gerhard W. Kundinger, age 89 of Sebewaing, died Saturday, April 10, 2010 at Bay regional Medical Center in Bay City following a brief illness.

He was born February 15, 1921 in Brookfield Township, Huron County, in the home where he lived his whole life. He was the son of the late Frederick J. and Louise A. (Radloff) Kundinger.

He was united in marriage to Donelda E. Licht on May 31, 1952 at Cross Lutheran Church in Pigeon. She preceded him in death on December 28, 1999.
