Who's on the Team?

Team members are appointed to a two-year term.

Each SWAT team consists of:

- 10 IFB[®] members
- 1 IFB Board Member
- 1 County Farm Bureau[®] Manager

What is the Goal of the Team?

Surface - Identify issues and provide vision to the IFB Board of Directors on topics relating to agriculture.

Research – Take part in the policy development process through in-depth review of issues for grassroots input.

Lead – Guide Illinois Farm Bureau, as an expert, on specific issues, regulations, and legislation.

When does the Team Meet?

Teams meet four times each year. If needed, those meetings may be supplemented with conference calls.

Team members will be reimbursed for necessary expenses.
