## PLACE MAKER

Seventy-six-year-old artist Marcia Ruth is literally putting Sacramento on the map with **Kinesthetic Classics**, a collection of 3-D topographical sculptures laser-cut from birch plywood and hand-assembled at Ruth's home in Tahoe Park. Based on data from the U.S. Geological Survey, each map is meticulously detailed to show layer after layer of mountain ranges and deep valleys. Ruth began her series in 2013 with a depiction of the Golden State and has since recreated the California Delta, Yosemite National Park and a puzzle map of San Francisco's neighborhoods. Her pieces (which cost \$55-\$345 each) are sold on Etsy and at the Artists' Collaborative Gallery in Old Sacramento, and she is currently working on dinner plate-sized sculptures of all 50 U.S. states. Ruth's next goal? To create maps for each country in the world—or as she puts it, to conquer the world piece by piece. [kinestheticclassics.com](http://kinestheticclassics.com)
