Support: Based on first hand experience we can provide advice, practical help when support and where needed. Much of our support is given in hospital prior to the operation and just after the operation.

And after: The Amputees and Carers Support Group is an active and dynamic group who meet regularly and organise social events to benefit members.

Our social day is every Wednesday between 10.30am -3.30pm where you can chat and socialise with other people in a similar situation as yourself. We also provide day trips on specially adapted vehicles.




### News
