* * You must be a financial member of the AGHS to register or transfer a horse in your name.

If you are not a current financial member of the AGHS you will require the:

Membership Application Form/Renewal Form (MUST be signed by the applicant wishing to join the AGHS)

Other forms you may need to consider when first joining the AGHS include:

Stud Prefix Form (if not already completed on the membership form)

Horse Registration:

Horse Registration Forms include:

Registration Form (Gypsy Cob, Drum/Foundation or Partbred registration form)

Upgrade Adult Registration Form (Required for foal recorded horses by the age of 2)

DNA Analysis Form (currently required for all Gypsy Cobs and Drums)

Stallion Service Certificate (Required for all horse registrations)

Certificate of Soundness Form (Required for all Stallions and must be signed by a vet)

* Equivalent forms accepted from recognised societies for reciprocal registrations

Microchip Number (Required for all horse registrations)

Other items required:

Photo's of your horse standing square from front, back and sides. (see photo guide on the web – digital copies can be emailed)

Payment (Receipt of online payment or cheque/money order/voucher to accompany paperwork)

Registration Certificate and a copy of Passport/Import documents (if imported)

Certificate of Castration (for all geldings)

Transfer/Lease Certificate if selling/leasing an AGHS Registered horse.
