SCAMS

How to avoid scams

- 1. Do not talk to telemarketers.
 - a. Use an answering machine.

Telemarketers usually won't leave a message.

b. Get Caller I.D.

Only answer calls from phone numbers that you recognize.

- c. Hang up if there is a long hesitation before someone responds. Telemarketers make several calls at a time and talk to the first person who answers.
- d. If you are not interested, Hang up.
- 2. If you do talk to them, trust your instincts.
 - a. Never give out personal information:
 - Credit card numbers
 - Bank ID numbers
 - Driver's license number
 - Social Security number

It's illegal for telemarketers to ask for this information to claim a prize or gift.

- b. Ask what state or federal agencies the company is registered with or regulated by.
- c. Get it in writing.
 If the offer sounds "too good to be true," it probably is. Don't be pressured.
- d. Ask to be put on Do-Not-Call lists.
- e. Keep a call log.

Write down dates and times you've received calls when you'd requested to not be called.

But even when he's too much to endure Your father loves you, that much is sure




PROM KING AND QUEEN
