(For use by adults during special events and activities if the participant is under 18 years of age.)

Said undersigned parent and natural guardian or legal guardian does hereby represent that he/she is, in fact, acting in such capacity and agrees on behalf of the participant and his/her executors, administrators, heirs, next of kin, successors, and assigns, to:

- a. waive, release, and discharge from any and all liability for participant's death, disability, personal injury, property damage, property theft or actions of any kind which may hereafter accrue to participant and his/her estate, the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents and employees; and
- b. indemnify and hold harmless the State of South Dakota, and its officers, agents and employees from and against any and all liabilities and claims made by other individuals or entities as a result of participant's participation or actions during this activity or event.

The undersigned further consents to and authorizes medical treatment to the participant, which may be deemed advisable in the event of injury, accident or illness during this activity or event.

Refunds:

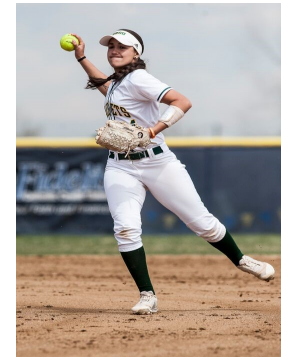
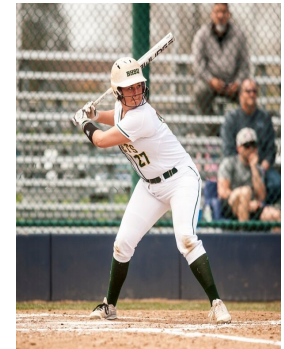
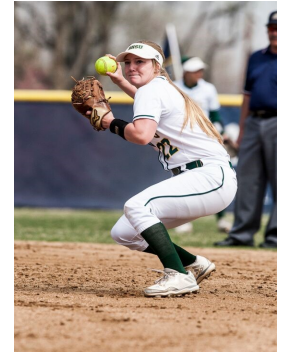
Black Hills State University allows no refunds due to personal injury, any conflicting camps or tournaments, vacations, inclement weather etc.

2018/19 Softball Camp Information



Leedy enters her fifth season as head coach of the Black Hills State University softball team in 2018. In her time at Black Hills State Leedy coached 10 All Conference Athletes, and 20 All Academic Conference Athletes. In 2015, Erica Everson became the first Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference 1st team awardee as well as the 1st NCAA All-Region performer. This past season Leedy lead the Yellow Jackets to their most conference wins all time since joining the

RMAC in 2012. Leedy spent the 2013-14 season as the interim head coach at the University of Toledo, leading the Rockets to its best season since 2005 while helping the school to its first season with a winning percentage of .500 or better on its home field. Having extensive experience in the travel ranks, Leedy compiled a record of 232-67 over five years for the Ohio Stingrays. She helped lead the Stingrays to two ASA State Championships and a Regional PGF title. She also helped 57 of her players earn college scholarships. Along with the travel experience, Leedy was the varsity assistant coach for Lexington High School and Tuscarawas Central Catholic. She was also the head coach of Newcomerstown High School where she led the program to its first-ever winning record along with a sectional championship and district runner-up performances.

Assistant Coach Caitlin Blanchard, a native of Petersburg, Mich., spent her collegiate career at the University of Michigan where she started 205 career games, winning four Big Ten Championships and competing in the Women's College World Series in 2013. She spent two seasons at catcher and two seasons at first base. She was named First Team All-Big Ten in 2013 as a first basemen and to the Third Team All-Big Ten in 2011 as a catcher. Blanchard was named to the Academic All-Big Ten and received the U of M Athletic Academic Achievement Award during her academic career while majoring in History. Caitlin primarily works with hitters and catchers but is involved with every aspect everyday softball at Black Hills State.

2018 Camp Options

Yellow Jackets Elite Prospect Camp
