On **Monday, March 14th**, the Claremont Wildlands Conservancy will present via Zoom about their work to establish permanent areas above Claremont and near La Verne for leisure and recreational use. The Conservancy recently won a significant monetary grant toward the purchase of Clara Oaks, which will link together other land tracts in the Conservancy's quest to create a natural landscape corridor from Claremont to Monrovia. Preservation is about land as well as houses and neighborhoods, so come listen to this educational and inspirational meeting.
