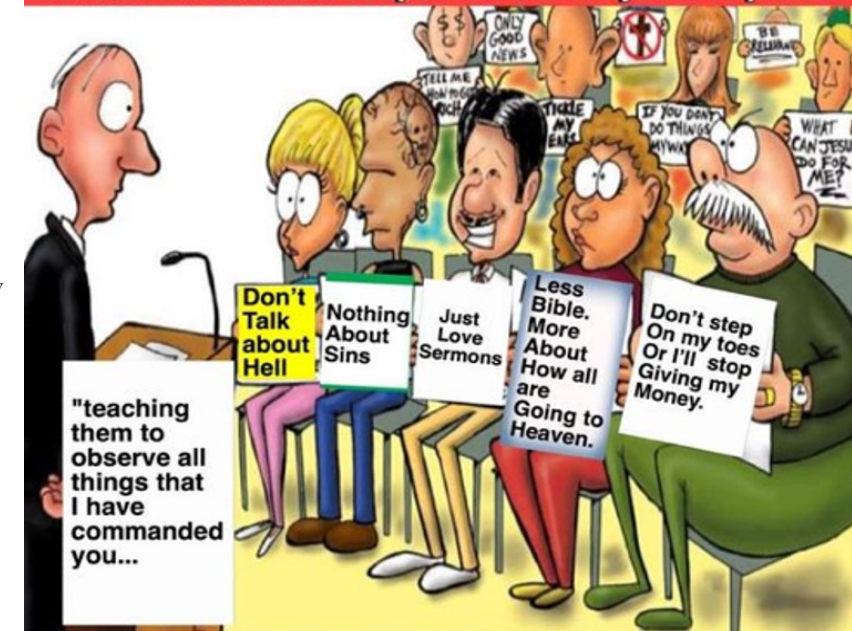

### **“A SPIRIT OF FEAR?”**

Most recently Willette has been bombarded with sickness. Covid is making another round, cancer is still ravaging bodies, other diseases are taking their toll, and various physical problems have required surgeries.

Those who are atheists would have us to believe that there is no God because of the fact that humanity must endure suffering.

But, if we stop to think about the origin of our suffering, we could say, at least to a degree, that this suffering has been brought on by mankind himself.
