Guidance for Communal Worship during the COVID-19 Pandemic – Step 4 Although most legal restrictions relating to the Covid pandemic are ending on Monday 19th July, a degree of caution is still needed to protect the vulnerable in the parish. Track and Trace: although no longer legally required, it has been recommended that we continue to "check in" with the NHS QR code poster, or manually.

Face coverings: should still be worn by all those coming to a church service (exemptions for medical reasons excluded.).

Social distancing will not be mandatory in our church. However, there will be socially distanced seats available.

Hand sanitising will remain necessary on arrival.

Holy Communion For the time being we will continue to distribute Holy Communion to parishioners in the benches.
