





Doug Hooper is one of the first drivers to have brought Corvette to the international stage following his win in California in October 1962 in the new Sting Ray Split Window Z06 racing option. In December '62, Zora Arkus-Duntov asked Doug to test his new secret project – the Grand Sport. After the test, Doug was scheduled to co-drive the Grand Sport at LeMans in June 1963. But in mid-February 1963, the GM sponsored race program ended.

Most racing fans recognize these names as the drivers of the Owens–Corning Fiberglass Corvettes in the late '60s and early '70s. They were the most successful duet in FIA and SCCA, winning 22 straight races from 1969 to 1971. "Jer" landed a job at Chevrolet in 1960 and a year later began racing a '56 Corvette at Detroit area tracks. During the '65–'66 season Jer and Tony met, became friends and competitors. Their OC racing record was

Since January's 24-hour Daytona race, Corvette Racing competed in the FIA WEC (World Endurance Champion-ship) series. The goal for the WEC races is to continue development of the mid-engine Corvette against similar manufacturer-backed competition they face in the IMSA GT Le Mans class.

In late February at COTA in Texas, Corvette Racing entered one mid-engine Corvette, the No. 63, driven by Jan Magnussen and Mike (Rocky) Rockenfeller.

Three practice sessions held the day prior to the race added more to the team's notebook of data on the new C8.R. The No.63 performed well during the race, but BoP restrictions really handicapped the C8.R against the other LMGTE PRO race teams.

The team enjoyed a trouble-free event with a sixth-place class finish. Jan and Rocky each made their first starts in the mid-engine Corvette C8.R, completing 170 laps for 570 miles in the highly competitive GTE Pro category.

No driver mistakes were made and the Corvette Racing pit team turned in its usual exemplary performance. Ample feedback and data were collected for study in preparation of upcoming races in both the FIA World Endurance Championship and the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship this season.

Corvette Racing will compete in both series at the Super Sebring weekend March 20-21 in Florida: the Mobil 1 Twelve Hours of Sebring for IMSA and the 1,000 Miles of Sebring for FIA WEC.
