

The Mayor's House Little Free Library

The Mayor's House Little Free Library (LFL) is located on Eastern Avenue and is stewarded by Kristyn Kuhn Eckel, an ECA member. She saw LFLs in other towns and she liked them. She and her husband are renovating what was the long-time home of former Annapolis Mayor Ellen Moyer. They have christened their home as the Mayor's House, hence the name of the LFL in front. With its ideal location at the end of First Street, Kristyn thought it was a perfect place to install her own LFL.

Kristyn considered building her little free library herself from the plethora of online designs but decided that she would purchase a pre-built house from the Little Free Library (<https://littlefreelibrary.org/>). She selected the design for its charm, appeal, and size. The library came unfinished. She painted it and her husband Jeff made and attached a sturdy mounting pole to pre-built house.

The Mayor's House LFL books are mostly for adult readers. The gamut of the books ranges from novels, non-fiction, How-To's, even comic books! Sometimes, children books will be left by others.

Kristyn gets a kick out of witnessing how the library is being used. People stop by to browse the books, take a book, or leave books.
