Here's a note from Robin Fayette regarding the donation that came from our Garage Sale (after we sold over \$400 worth!!!)...

After the July phlocking, Debi gave me the remaining clothing & accessories to donate to Women Helping Women/Men2Work. I have worked with this organization for almost 10 years through my Fountain Valley Woman's Club and Debi had previously given me clothing that did not sell at our Club's "garage sales" to donate to them. This year there were 179 pieces of women's and men's clothing plus a few purses and a belt with a donation value of <u>\$608.92</u>. Some of the items were of business quality that the organization can use directly for their clients, with the rest being donated to their quarterly sales to raise money for their program.

FYI – Women Helping Women (WHW) was founded over 20 years ago by two women who had been lawyers, found themselves in abusive situations while stay at home moms and needed to find a way out and become self-sufficient. WHW gets referrals from approx. 60 agencies in Orange County and provides business clothing, purses, shoes, etc. for women who want to get back into the work force and become independent, but have no financial or other resources to do so. WHW also provides computer training, resume assistance and job interview training, plus a haircut and/or color, all free of charge. Gaining confidence is just a side benefit from the program. A few years ago they expanded to provide the same services to men through their Men2Work program. They are now receiving referrals of returning veterans, both men and women.

WHW holds a quarterly Saturday Sale with all of the non-business appropriate **donations, like OCPHC's, at their main facility at 1800 E. McFadden in Santa** Ana. Higher-end items are also included!! The next sale is Nov. 1st. There is **a lot more I could say about the success of WHW and how I've watched grow** tremendously in the past 10 years, but better to pass on their website <u>www.whw.org</u> for members who want more information.
