New Business	VBAC Criteria	Need something in place in regards to VBAC criterial because there is nothing formal for VBAC criterial the hospital. VBAC criteria was taken from the ACC practice bulletins and sent to all the Physicial practices. Basically the bulletins say that Physicial must be in house when doing VBACs. Discussionals also took place regarding setting a limit on the number of prior C-Sections a patient may have protocolor to allowing them to do a TOLAC. ACOG practing guidelines were not available at this meeting.

		Changes with staffing were discussed. OB has filled one of the FT night positions and hired a traveler for a 13 week contract.
		Still awaiting results from the Perinatal Risk Assessment conducted on April 14 and 15. Currently working on getting all of the standards on the unit along with the ACOG practice bulletins, looking into purchasing a transcutaneous bilirubin meter, and putting together an education packet on documentation for the staff.
		It was recommended that we get the AmniSure laboratory test here for ROM to test for protein and amniotic fluid. This test is much more sensitive and accurate than Nitrazine. AmniSure is about 98-100% specific and sensitive to a true ROM. OB Manager to meet with laboratory to discuss cost and bring to the next meeting.
