I would also like to thank Scott Rick. He is a member of Boy Scout Pack 525 in Anaheim Hills. Scott had approached Post 132 a couple of months ago wanting to work on a project for his Eagle Scout Patch at the Post. After talking with him, he decided on making bags for our homeless Veterans. Scott, along with three other members of his pack, Michael DiCarlo, Parker Hayden, and Preston Hayden, succeeded in making 100 bags for our Veterans. They were presented Post 132 at our General Meeting in September. I know the bags will be appreciated by our Veterans who receive them. Seventy bags were made for males and 30 bags for females. If you see the pictures in the Bugle you'll see what was placed in each bag.

Another organization I would like to show our appreciation for is, The Community Foundation of Orange/Field of Valor. The Executive Director, Susie Cunningham, and the foundation have shown their appreciation to Post 132 by donating a substantial monetary amount to our Homeless Veterans Program. This was the 3rd donation in 2 years from them. The foundation is a big supporter of our Post and we hope to continue having a working relationship with them. I'm also honored to have been asked to carry the Marine Corps Colors at the opening ceremonies on Nov 10, 2018 which is also The Marine Corps' birthday.

I would like to see a big showing from Post 132's family at the opening ceremonies at Handy Park. If you do show up, please wear your Post cap. You can also be a volunteer for the Field of Valor. Just sign up and volunteer your time. Also, the Post Color Guard has been asked to retire the Colors on Nov 17 at Handy Park.

Wow, another month is gone and pretty soon it will be Christmas. At least we will get cooler weather.

Clubroom Bar daily attendance has been up and down and you never know what to expect from one day to another. As long as we have some rentals, we will be able to stay open. In August, not much happened. We had one Rental scheduled for upstairs but it cancelled so we only got the \$300.00 Rental deposit. Besides the \$500.00 for the north parking lot rent, we received a memorial donation of \$200.00 and a building fund donation of \$50.00 from our good friend, J.P. Woodward. We also got \$28.00 from the donation box inside the Museum.

The Street Fair weekend started before the end of August so I will report on it entirely since I will be on vacation next month and will not have an article for the Bugle. We also got \$144.19 from Katella Grill and \$87.25 from Zito's Pizza Fundraisers arranged by our 2nd Vice Commander William Stringfield. He puts a lot of time into these and should be receiving more support. The Auxiliary kicked off first with their Donation of \$200.00 for The Children's Halloween Party. Other donations that come in later this month will be reported with October.

In the Legion Account, 31 members paid their dues in August and the Third and Fourth Friday Opportunity Drawings brought in \$220.00 for Bugle support.
