A Note from Rick: Mixed markets at TLA this week. Mixed fats and Holstein steers were both \$3 to \$5 higher this week, while slaughter cows were weaker. Both of these markets have been trending in these directions over the last several weeks. I'd say that this week the moves were a little bigger. Slaughter cow numbers continue to increase and that puts a lot of pressure on prices. This seems to happen every year in the Fall and I look for this market to struggle in the short term. Dairy cattle prices remain steady. We had our Special Springer Sale on Thursday and the market was very similar to the September Sale. Over half of the heifers brought from \$1250-\$1525 and although that's quite a bit higher than they've been over the last 12 months, it's still well below the cost of production. The Friesian Fall Classic is finally here October 17th-19th and it's going to be bigger than ever. We are also expecting a lot of high quality horses in the Fall Draft Horse Auction October 28th-November 1st. There is a lot of action happening at Topeka Livestock Auction this Fall and we are looking forward to having some great Auctions. Come check us out! See you at TLA!
